Admission Requirements

- Complete the Cincinnati State online application for admission
- Complete the COMPASS placement test and achieve the required scores
- Submit official copies of high school and/or college transcripts
- Ohio BCI&I and FBI background checks
- Physical examination with TB skin test and all required vaccines

Applicants to the **Paramedic Certificate Program** must also submit copies of the following:

- Ohio EMT certification
- NREMT certification
- American Heart Association BLS for HCP card or equivalent
- Certificates of completion for NIMS IS-100.B and IS -700.A
- Driver's license
