Role of Committee Members

- Review and provide input on draft statements, op-eds, and media releases.
- Ensure accuracy, clarity, and alignment with the Academy's mission.
- Serve as behind-the-scenes subject matter experts — helping the Academy speak with authority, while shielding individual members from institutional or political risk.

Non-Partisan:

- *We advocate for medicine and patients, not for politics or institutions.*

Collective Voice:

- *Editorials, press responses, and official statements will be published under the Academy of Medicine's name — protecting individual physicians who may be limited in their ability to comment publicly.*

- *We monitor emerging headlines and provide rapid, reliable responses the community can trust.*
